Introduction


This document has been prepared to provide the supporting evidence for a potential community facilities policy within the Ipplepen Neighbourhood Plan.

It serves as record of the existing community facilities within the parish of Ipplepen which should be safeguarded for community use in to the future. This document sets out the location and boundaries of the facility and provides photographs for visual identification.

Information on the premises facilities such as toilets or meeting rooms, activities undertaken there and their frequency have been identified where available. Information on the sites accessibility such as wheelchair access and parking availability have also been recorded.


The document also includes a short summary on the value of the site/premises to the community.

Serves as a community hub providing the religious and non-religious a place to meet and interact. It provides a place for hire for local activities and is also home to the parish council office.



Serves as the only available health service within walking distance of the residents of lpplepen, providing an easily accessible service to local residents with particular advantages for the elderly and less mobile.



Ipplepen Village Hall is the primary community congregational space for the local community. It provides one large and one medium sized room for a variety of events to be held. These include the local history group, keep fit class, coffee mornings, art class and the film society to name but a few. In addition the space also serves as the polling station for the village during elections and accommodates one off events such as community consultation exercises. The facility has audio visual equipment, toilets and kitchen facilities which all add to the facilities versatility and overall value to the community.

It furthers the social well-being and social interests of the local community through the provision of suitable space and equipment to undertake a wide range of community activities, provides a space to exercise and socialise with community members and a large enough space for one-off community information events.



The asset is currently used as the Saplings pre-school education facility which provides pre-school services to children between the ages of 2 years and 6 months and 5 years.

This provides a vital service for local parents and children to access pre-school education within walking distance of local homes without the need for access to the private car or public transport.

The Millennium Centre also provides an extension to the services of the nearby Ipplepen Primary School, providing space for a daily breakfast and after school clubs.

The asset therefore provides a significant contribution to furthering the social wellbeing of the local community.



It provides a focal point for parental activity and provides a focal point for social interaction and community life.



The asset is currently a public house which is the only non-members, public facility in which to engage in informal activities in the village.



The shop provides a focal point for residents to informally meet and interact which provides contact between residents which may not have occurred through more formal venues and events.


The presence of the Co-op enables informal social interaction between community members, provides an easily accessible source of everyday grocery items.

It provides access to services which would otherwise have to be accessed within Totnes or Newton Abbot and therefore provides a vital lifeline to those without access to the private car and/or those with more limited mobility.

The post office provides a focal point for residents to informally meet and interact which provides contact between residents which may not have occurred through more formal venues and events.

The presence of the Post Office enables informal social interaction between community members and provides local access to financial and postal services.


