- 5. Totnes Road Footpath Path Project Cllr. Smith and Cllr. Rattlidge meeting was arranged with Sam Williams of Devon Highways on 1st February 2024 at Dainton to discuss if we might be permitted to install pipes and backfill the gully in order to continue the path towards Newton Abbot.
- 6. Urban Speed Limiters Cllr. Smith reported that he had a response from Kingskerswell Parish Council to installation costs of their VAS speed signs, which was £13000 for three units and software to be able to download. It was decided to ask Sam Williams of Devon Highways when at the meeting on the 1st February for suggestions of what is available.

- 7. Public Rights of Way Inspections Cllr. Smith reported that Devon County are still looking for a new officer. We are still waiting for paperwork to be sent out. Simon Birbeck had been contacted to arrange inspection of footpaths to decide what repairs were needed at a later date.
- 8. Flood Reduction Cllr. Smith reported that he had received a map of locations of Buddle-hole in our Parish from Cllr. Dewhurst. It was decided that at the moment the limestone underground is saturated, the fields flood and the water finds its own level. Moor Road still under discussion possible service dressing?
